Application

Acceptance into the LSU AgCenter Louisiana Master Gardener Training Program is based upon your qualifications and the current volunteer needs of the County Agent. Space is limited due to compliance with COVID-19 mandates.

Fees

If accepted, you will be required to pay a \$225 course fee, covering the cost of training materials, name tags, classroom supplies, and simple refreshments. A separate fee of \$20 is required for membership in the St. Tammany Parish Master Gardener Association. **Do not send any payments with this application.**

Program

The program is presented in-person with some online components. Classes will take place on **Tuesday evenings** from **5:00 PM – 8:00 PM** at the Mandeville Department of Public Works Building (**1100 Mandeville High Blvd, Mandeville, LA 70471**). Lecture material will be presented in a traditional classroom format with activities and demonstrations as needed. Chapter quizzes, evaluations, and a final exam are utilized to maintain progress. Students will be required to attend all training sessions, field trips, review all program material, and complete all required activities. Field trips may require additional time and travel to offsite locations.
